Recommended Action

- A. Direct staff to tabulate Prop. 218 ballots received by the close of the public hearing.
- B. Adopt resolution to include water fee increases for future fiscal years for the El Macero County Service Area (CSA).
- C. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to forward a certified copy of the resolution to the Department of Financial Services.

Strategic Plan Goal(s)

Provide fiscally sound, dynamic and responsive services

Reason for Recommended Action/Background

The recommended actions are required to obtain authority to modify the rate/fee for water service in the El Macero County Service Area. These changes have been included in the Notices of Public Hearing and Protest. If the change or increase is subject to a majority protest, services to the community will be impacted. Based on the City of Davis' escalating water fee, and El Macero's full

cost recovery of increased prices for operations and maintenance of the water system, the annual water expenditures will exceed annual water revenue in 2015/2016 should the proposed fee increases not occur.

Over the last several years, the cost to provide water service has increased significantly, and in order to continue to provide the service at cost, the county needs to increase revenues collected from property owners within the district. Any change in the water fee is subject to Proposition 218, which requires more than 50%, plus one of the property owners to successfully protest a fee increase.

The City of Davis is the provider of the services through agreement with the CSA. The CSA has been paying the same price for water services as a City of Davis resident would within the City. This will not change with the new fee increase. The city charges the CSA per resident based on a meter base charge for a ½", 1", or 1 ½"meter and a meter consumption rate charge including a \$/ccf calculation. Each property owner in the El Macero CSA pays a water charge based on the amount of water that is consumed. The Property owner pays the CSA and the CSA pays the City of Davis that same amount. This City of Davis rate has been steadily increasing, and at this time the El Macero CSA must increase its water fee in order to pass through the same charge to its residents as the City is currently charging the CSA for water service. The residents are paying based on the previous proposition 218 fees that the City had undergone some years ago. Revenues will no longer equal expenditures if the CSA water charge does not equal the City water charge. In essence the proposed fee increase is a pass through from the City of Davis most recent Proposition 218 rate. The background of the City of Davis rate election is available at the City of Davis Finance Division.

RESOLUTION NO. 15 - 87

(Resolution Increasing Fees and Charges for Water Services in the El Macero County Service Area)

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors ("Board") is authorized by Government Code Sections 25210 and following to provide water service in the El Macero County Service Area and to levy service fees and charges to pay for those services; and

WHEREAS, in 1977 this Board previously exercised that authority to provide for the maintenance and operation of the water system servicing the El Macero County Service Area through a contract with the City of Davis and levied service fees and charges to pay for those services; and

WHEREAS, although the costs of providing those services have increased significantly since then, the services fees and charges have not been increased since 2008; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2015, a written board report, was filed with this Board recommending increased water fees and charges for the El Macero County Service Area, for the fiscal year 2015-16 and for each year thereafter; and

WHEREAS, based upon that report, on June 9, 2015 this Board initiated proceedings to consider increasing the El Macero County Service Area water fees and charges, and set a public hearing for 9:00 a.m. on July 28, 2015 to consider the proposed fee increases, the report, any protests against the proposal, any other information in support of or in opposition to the proposal, and all other relevant information; and

WHEREAS, thereafter the Clerk of this Board gave notice, at the times and in the manner required by law, that this Board would hold a public hearing during its regular public meeting on July 28, 2015 at 625 Court Street, Woodland, California, to consider approval of the proposed increases to water service fees and charges; and

WHEREAS, said Notice contained the date, time, and place of the public meeting as set forth above; a general explanation of the matter to be considered; the amount of the fee or charge proposed to be imposed upon each parcel, the basis upon which the amount of the proposed fee or charge was calculated, and the reason for the fee or charge; and stated that a detailed fee analysis concerning the proposed fee increases, including the cost or estimated cost, of providing the service for which each fee is proposed to be charged, the revenue sources anticipated to provide the service (including general fund revenues), and the bases of the allocation of the cost of the services, was available for review at the Office of the Clerk of the Board; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2015 the proposed increases came on regularly for hearing before this Board during its regular public meeting, at the time and place specified in the Notice; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2015, this Board opened a public hearing on the water service fees and charges; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2015, the public hearing for levying fees and charges for water service for the El Macero County Service Area was conducted; and

WHEREAS, at said hearing, this Board reviewed and considered the proposed fees and charges, all supporting information including but not limited to the data described above, any protests against the proposal, any other information in support of or in opposition to the proposal, and all other relevant information presented as prescribed by law; and

WHEREAS, at that time, an opportunity was given to all interested persons, organizations, and agencies to present oral or written testimony and other information concerning the proposed fees and all related matters; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was thereafter closed, on July 28, 2015; and

WHEREAS, <u>24</u> written protest had been filed with the Clerk of the Board, and **0** further protests were submitted prior to or during the July 28, 2015 hearing; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2015, Resolution No. 15-87 was brought forth to the Board of Supervisors for approval including the future increases that were noticed through letters to the El Macero County Service Area, public notices, staff reports, and at the public hearing; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo as follows:

- 1. Each of the foregoing recitals is true and correct.
- 2. There are 467 parcels subject to the proposed water service fee increase; the <u>24</u> protests are therefore not sufficient to constitute a majority protest.
- 3. This Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the El Macero County Service Area Report, Notice of Fee Increase Proceedings and Public Hearing attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference.
- 4. Based upon the foregoing, this Board is also authorized to levy fees and charges for water service on parcels lying within the El Macero County Service Area on an ongoing basis, year by year, in an amount as is stated in the Notice of Fee Increase on a per parcel basis. Water fees shall be increased by the set rate structure shown in the Notice per year in fiscal years 2015/2016. Thereafter, water fees shall be increased annually as needed by not more than the Consumer Price Index (CPI-W and CPI-U) for the San Francisco-Oakland-San Jose, CA area for the most recent February to February as compiled by the Bureau of Labor Statistics.
- 5. Based upon the foregoing, this Board hereby levies the fees and charges for water services on parcels lying within the El Macero County Service Area on an ongoing basis, year by

year, in the amounts set forth Notice of Public Hearing attached hereto as Exhibit A, to be adjusted annually by the approved increases herein

- 6. This Board further finds that each of the following is true and correct:
 - A. Each fee or charge imposed herein is a levy other than an ad valorem tax, a special tax or an assessment, and is imposed upon a parcel or a person as an incident of property ownership consisting of a user fee or charge for water service.
 - B. These water service fee and charges are property related services, having a direct relation to property ownership.
 - C. Revenues derived from the fee or charge imposed herein will not exceed the funds required to provide property related water service in the El Macero County Service Area.
 - D. The revenues derived from the fee will not be used for any other purpose other than that for which the fee is imposed.
 - E. The fee imposed herein does not exceed the proportional cost of service attributable to each parcel.
 - F. No fee is imposed unless sewer and water service is actually used by, or immediately available to, the owner of the property in question. No fee is imposed on the basis of a mere potential of future use of either service.
 - G. No fee is imposed for any general governmental service or any service where the service is available to the public at large in substantially the same manner as it is to property owners.
- 8. This Board further finds that each parcel set forth in said revised written report is a parcel lying within the El Macero County Service Area for which water services are available and that each such parcel is a parcel of real property receiving said services in the El Macero County Service Area.
- 9. It is further ordered that the service fees and charges as levied hereinabove shall be collected at the same time and in the same manner as ordinary County Ad Valorem Taxes are collected and as provided in Chapter 8 of Title 3 of the Yolo County Code.
- 10. The Clerk is hereby ordered to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Auditor-Controller and the Treasurer-Tax Collector of the County of Yolo, and the Auditor-Controller is hereby requested to post said fees and charges beginning in the 2015-16 tax roll of the County.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN as follows:

The Yolo County Board of Supervisors is considering a fee increase for water services for parcels in the the El Macero County Service Area. The increase will generate additional revenue required to match expenditures charged by the City of Davis for water services to the CSA. If approved, the increased fee will be levied upon all benefited parcels of land within the County Service Area as follows:

Note: All monthly charges will continue to be compiled and charged <u>annually</u> on the property tax bill for each individual property owner. The fees are not deductible from federal or state income taxes.

Thereafter, water service fees may be increased by no more than the Consumer Price Index (CPI-W and CPI-U) for the San Francisco-Oakland-San Jose, CA area for the most recent February to February as compiled by the Bureau of Labor Statistics as necessary to pay for the costs of providing sewer services.

At 9:00 a.m. (or as soon thereafter as circumstances permit) on July 28, 2015, in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, at 625 Court Street, Room 206, Woodland, California, the Board of Supervisors will hold a Public Hearing to consider the proposed fee increase, and to receive and consider all public comments, including but not limited to the counting of any ballots in protest of the proposed fee increase received by the Clerk of the Board at the time of the Public Hearing. Should ballots opposing the proposed fee increase

^{**} Surcharge rates will not be applied unless the City of Davis adopts a required resolution and imposes surcharges under the identified drought stage. These charges are not in effect at this time.

exceed 50 percent plus 1 of the parcels in the affected County Service Area, the increase will not be imposed.

The service that is the subject of this proposed fee increase is described in the City of Davis Municipal Code and was adopted by the City of Davis in a prior Proposition 218 election with documents on file at the City of Davis.

An Engineer's Report provides the basis for calculating the proposed fee increase. This report is available to the public concerning the proposed fee, including the cost or estimated cost of providing the service for which the fee is proposed to be charged, the revenue sources anticipated to provide the service (including general fund revenues), and the bases of the allocation of the cost of the services. This information is available for review at the City of Davis Administrative Offices or attainable through the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, at 625 Court Street, Room 204, Woodland, California.

All interested persons are invited to attend and be heard at the time of the hearing. As provided in state law, including but not limited to Article XIII.D of the California Constitution, any interested person may file a ballot for or against the proposed assessment with the Clerk of the Board at 625 Court Street, Room 204, Woodland, California, before the close of the public hearing.
