- 5. Report: Health Council (HC), Scott Hatcher reported:
  - a. Budgets are a major concern for the upcoming and unknown changes to the Affordable Care Act. More information to come.
  - b. HC has been looking into <u>Harm Reduction Services/Safe Points Syringe Exchange</u> program for Sharps disposal for all of Yolo County and will be writing a letter to the BOS with an action plan.
  - c. Harm Reduction Services also has an Overdose Prevention program that will train people in administering Narcan.

#### 7. Discussion: UC Davis & YEMSA Training Partnership

a. Nate Trauernicht reported in 2015/2016 UC Davis Fire Department started looking into a Prehospital Care Coordinator position. The position would run and supervise a wide range of training programs and would work a 40 hour work week. At the same time YEMSA was in need of training personnel to roll out new protocols and trainings, a discussion then started with combing the position within the two agencies. An agreement was drafted and it was then sent to each agency's legal departments where it sat for a prolong period. The key function of the position would be to improve educational opportunities, to make sure EMS Responders are getting standardized training for better quality of care, and to help the EMS System as a whole. YEMSA would be contributing 50,000.00 to the partnership position with the salary savings from a vacant EMS Specialist Position that was funded by YEMSA Penalty funds. The project will now be taken to the EMCC Penalty Funds Subcommittee in April for final discussion and input from the advisory committee.
