Yolo County Library's Books by Mail Service

(Woodland, CA) – Yolo County Library continues to provide Books by Mail, a free service that delivers library materials to Yolo County residents through the mail.

This program is designed for residents that are prevented from visiting a Yolo County Library branch due to a disability, illness, or lack of regular transportation. After completing an application and speaking with library staff, residents can request specific materials be mailed to them directly and may even request that library staff select materials for them based on personal interest.

“You pick out books that I enjoy reading,” said a Books by Mail recipient. “I am surprised and pleased with the service.”

Residents can be sent items such as audiobooks, regular and large print fiction and non-fiction books, international language materials, music CDs, magazines, and DVDs in the library's collection. Items will be loaned for four weeks.

There is no cost to sign up for this program and no cost to return items, as residents will receive library materials in a reusable canvas book mailer with postage pre-paid by the library.

This program was made possible by an Institute of Museum and Library Services grant, the Pinkerton Foundation, the California State Library, and donations from the community and the Friends of the Davis Public Library.
