New eBooks Available at Yolo County Library

(Woodland, CA) – Yolo County Library has added 60,000 more eBooks through Enki, a lending eBook platform created by California libraries. Enki enriches the Yolo County Library eBook collection by providing online access to popular fiction and nonfiction genres such as romance, mysteries, sci-fi, westerns, graphic novels, crafts, and cooking.

Yolo County Library patrons can log onto Enki at https://yolo.enkilibrary.org/ from any Internet connected computer using their library card number and PIN. Patrons can check out Enki eBooks for a period of up to 21 days and check out 20 Enki titles at a time using a smartphone, tablet, or computer. There are no fines on Enki eBooks as the system returns the books at the end of the check-out period.

"We are excited to see Enki join our digital eBook collection," said Interim County Librarian Chris Crist. "Yolo County Library can now provide access to self-published and indie published digital content for our patrons."

Enki is unique from other e-services because it provides digital content from small and independent publishers such as University of California Press, McGraw Hill, Permanent Press, Smashwords, and graphic novel publishers Dark Horse Press and Rosarium. Enki recently expanded its content with additional short stories, classics, encyclopedias, and 900 graphic novels.

Enki was created by the Contra Costa County Library and Califa Library Group. It is funded by a Bay Area Library Information Systems Innovation Grant, Library Services and Technology Act funds from the California State Library, and Califa.

Alongside Enki the Yolo County Library also offers additional resources for patrons to access online material. Through OverDrive individuals can download eBooks and eAudiobooks that include bestsellers, classics, fiction, and nonfiction books. This service is available through the library at www.yolocounty.overdrive.com. Patrons can also visit the Yolo County Library website at www.yolocountylibrary.org and click on eLibrary to find reading recommendations from Novelist and enjoy digital access to Flipster eMagazines such as *National Geographic*, *Good Housekeeping*, *Sunset*, *People* and more.
