Approval of Agenda: The committee voted to approve the meeting's agenda.

Closed Session: The committee met in closed session from 6:10pm until 6:30pm.

Public Comment: Richard Lauckhart spoke for 3 minutes on the following: the recent fund balance settlement and his recommendations to refund money to homeowners. He passed out multiple handouts to those in attendance.

Approval of Minutes, August 29, 2017 meeting: Tim Lien suggested several admendents. The committee voted to approve the meeting's minutes including Tim Lien's suggested changes.

County Supervisor's Report: Rich Reed discussed an upcoming public meetings concerning county marijuana regulations, and Union Pacific's request to close the crossing at the intersection of County Roads 105 and 32A, Caltrans future repair of their culvert pipe and valve at the west-end of Yolo Bypass to reduce flooding near I-80 on-ramp, and plans for future stop signs at Montgomery and Mace Blvd.

John McDonough provided an update on the Road Improvement Project.
