## December Programs at the Esparto Regional Library

(Woodland, CA) – All are welcome to participate in the following special programs held during the month of December at Yolo County’s Esparto Regional Library, located at 17065 Yolo Avenue in Esparto:

- **December 13: Free Computer Class, 10:30 a.m.** Basic computer class covering simple tech support, beginner terminology, library computer resources, and a Q&A session.
