## **Board of Supervisors Seeks Applications for Community Services Action Board**

(Woodland, CA) – The Yolo County Board of Supervisors is seeking applications for two openings on its Community Services Action Board, whose mission is to combat poverty by promoting the health, safety, stability and self-sufficiency of low-income persons residing in Yolo County.

The Community Services Action Board serves as an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors with the following primary functions:

- Convening bi-monthly meetings to evaluate local progress towards combating poverty in Yolo County;
- Conducting a biannual community needs assessment to identify critical gaps in Yolo County's social service system;
- Overseeing the provision of services using Community Services Block Grant funds by reviewing project proposals and making recommendations to the Board of Supervisors on how to expend the money;
- Monitoring the performance of Community Services Block Grant funded programs by examining outcome reports and conducting annual site visits; and
- Serving as advocates for Yolo County residents living in poverty.

The Community Services Action Board currently has two vacancies to be filled:

- 1 representative of a local civic organization
- 1 representative of District 2 (Supervisor Don Saylor's district in central and west Davis, as well as Winters and unincorporated areas in between)

The Community Services Action Board meets on the second Tuesday of every month from 4:30 to 6:00 p.m. in rotating locations among Davis, West Sacramento and Woodland.
