Garden Composting Class February 24

(Woodland, CA) – Are you interested in learning how to turn garbage into gold for your garden soil? Join the Yolo County Health & Human Services Agency at the Hanna & Herbert Bauer Memorial Community Garden in Woodland for a free garden composting class on Saturday, February 24 from 10:00 to 11:30 a.m.

In this hands-on class, participants will learn how to set up and maintain small scale compost systems with the goal of creating nutrient-rich soil to help fruits and vegetables grow well. Participants will have the benefit of learning from two garden experts, one Master Gardener of Yolo County, and the garden manager of the Hanna and Herbert Bauer Memorial Community Garden. This is a great opportunity for garden enthusiasts to discover various compost system designs and have questions answered.

This class is free to all, and is part of the Yolo County Health & Human Services Agency's commitment to providing education that can help residents eat fresh fruits and vegetables and live healthier lives.
