Yolo County Library Selected to Participate in Prestigious Digital Storytelling Project

California Listens: Collecting Stories about Being Californian is a project of the California State Library being implemented by Berkeley-based StoryCenter over the spring and summer of 2018.

Yolo County Library was one of 14 libraries in California selected for this project, which will focus on rural life in Yolo County and will be hosted by the Yolo Branch Library. We hope to collect a minimum of 10 digital stories, which will be created and recorded during two workshops in mid-July. We have the added benefit of working with U.C. Davis students who will assist with this project.

The stories will exist as a collection for the State Library, and for participating libraries. Technology will be provided by StoryCenter to implement the workshops. Yolo County Library will also host a screening event of the films made before the end of 2018.



Yolo County Archives Renovation Update

The Yolo County Archives and Records Center will be undergoing a two million dollar renovation in the Spring/Summer of 2018 to increase storage capacity and improve the control over the temperature and humidity of the facility. These changes will help to ensure that the existing collection is well preserved and that there is sufficient space for future acquisitions. The County is currently in the process of selecting a vendor for the compact storage shelving system that will be installed.
