
Yolo County CCP Environmental Scan Update



Revisions – Programs

- Changed Neighborhood Court language to include explanations from DA. (P. 5, 16, 26)
- ❖ Changed the data and language for the Public Defender Social Worker Program to show outcomes. (P. 5, 18, 30)
- ❖Included data from some HHSA treatment programs. (P. 5, 13, 18, 27-28)

Revisions – Format and Language

- Added in sources after every use of evidence throughout report.
- Changed section title language to be more specific. (P. 3-4, 10-11)
- ❖ Qualified the term recidivism as used by state (quoted the CDCR's definition), and rewrote language comparing Yolo County's definition to CDCR's definition. (P. 3, 6, 10, 19)
- ❖ Put in brief description for realignment and Prop 47 in the executive summary for context for readers. (P. 3)

Revisions – Format and Language (Continued)

- ❖ Changed language for criminogenic needs and added in language describing risk/ needs from literature review. Did not change from criminogenic needs to risk assessment since it is a more narrow measure. (P. 9)
- Changed language for the mental health booking data to better reflect the meaning of the data.
 (P. 12, 22, 25)
- Changed language for the BSCC "Assault on Staff" data to more accurately reflect what the data means. (P. 24)
- *Relabeled the "Selected County Crime Stats" as Unincorporated Yolo County. (P. 25)

Revisions - Data

- ❖ Replaced PPIC data with FBI UCR data for the California crime offense statistics. (P. 4, 6, 10, 19, 24)
- ❖ Replaced the BSCC data about court mandated capacity releases with Yolo County Sheriff data. Also wrote additional language to explain the nature of capacity releases for the county jail. (P. 5, 14, 31-32)
- ❖ Included AB 109 population in the average daily population graph, and checked against Yolo County Sheriff population data. (P. 11, 14, 23)
- ❖ Put data point values in all graphs (if feasible for visibility).

Revisions In-Progress

- Checking up on Cite and Release data.
- Checking up on Prop 47 misdemeanors vs. non-Prop 47 misdemeanors.
- ❖ Include more data from AB 109 treatment programs.
- ❖ Include more in-depth information about the jail population from the Yolo County Jail Survey.
