Services will be targeted for eligible population who meets medical necessity criteria

Seriously Emotionally Disturbed (SED) children and youth

Full Scope Medi-Cal

Early Periodic Screening and Treatment (EPSDT) eligible children and youth under the age of 21

Probation and Child Welfare Services involved children and youth

Intensive Services Wraparound may be provided for non Medi-Cal eligible children.

Services will have essential elements of trauma-informed practices

maximize physical and psychological safety

identify trauma-related needs

enhancement of well-being and resilience

partnership with the child/family to enhance sense of control through voice and choice

partnership with other child-serving agencies and systems
