3. RFP UPDATE -

- **Karen Larsen**-Recently applied for SB-82, the RFP for TAY was awarded first bucket of funding and we are now submitting an RFP for Children's for second round as well as the 3rd round of funding which is more competitive and aimed at School MH and Crisis
- A new RFP for Children's Specialty MH is out now and will be awarded before July 1st with no break in service

4. CALIFORNIA HUB AND SPOKE MODEL

MEDICALLY ASSISTED TREATMENT (MAT)

• **GARRETT STENSON-**Yolo County has never had Medication Assisted Treatment Available in the past. CORE West Sac will be opening soon. Discussed Hub and Spoke Model and what it will look like.

HUB-CORE WEST SACRAMENTO (Providers) will be used for the most difficult cases as a starting point for MAT and be the only location that offers Methadone **SPOKES-**(Refer to) lots of different hands in the community that can deliver Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) will work with Jails, ER and offer transportation, Outpatient Services, and Therapy. Locations in West Sacramento, Winters, Woodland, and Davis will be able to offer all Medication Assisted Treatment in house and by prescription except for Methadone (West Sac Only).

PROCESS-Clients will start on daily regimen of Methadone and step down to prescription for Suboxone which will make access easier for those outside of West Sac. They are working on expanding the program but for now the Spokes will offer RX and Refer back to HUB if client requires a higher level of care (Methadone) and the cycle will starts all over. An Access line will navigate the calls to the correct place for services once CORE starts but until then clients can continue to call Communicare

KITS-Kits reviewed that combat overdoses and are available with automated instructions for Providers reducing possibility of errors in use. First Responders, Ambulance and Fire now carry, and it is recommended that the SPOKES Providers also make available
