1. INTRODUCTIONS AND PROGRAM UPDATES

- **Karen**-Welcomed the group and introductions were completed.
- **Leigh**-Dr. Ozbayrak and Nora Kim two new Psychiatrists will begin on June 11th. Dr. Kim speaks both Korean and Spanish. Dr. Maxwell will be reducing hours; is looking to do MAT in community. The collaborative program with UCD Medical Center is working great.
- **Karen**-would like to acknowledge that Yolo County has been working on recruiting psychiatrist for 5 years so hiring two new is something to be celebrated
- **Leigh**- Cures California Registry Sign-up for prescribing medications and specialty medications is now required. This coming October before prescribing class 2,3, or 4 medications the Cures California Registry Database must be checked. This will help reduce the clients who may have been able to receive the same prescription from multiple providers. Ian states that the original MDP requirement for specialty medications excluded Methadone. Will have to review whether that is still the case.

- Ian Evan's and Carol West teamed up for a Continuum of Care Work Group presentation at CAO.
- National Stepping Up Day of Action is a Nationwide movement aimed at reducing the number of mentally ill in custody
- Art show coming up
- Pine Tree Gardens-operated as a Board and Care in Davis, people struggling with mental illness live in these homes. Turning point over sees and is trying to figure out how Pine Tree can be sustainable. Work on board and care statewide is in need of adequate funding
- Yolo Family Services Agency went out of business on April 30, 2018. Working with board to transition clients and employees, working through all of the logistics, Turning Point and CommuniCare have hired on some of the employees.
- SUD –was awarded contract from the State, Ian will be working on it
- We lost our HHSA Homeless Coordinator and HHSA Clinic Manager

- Governors May revised came out Friday-current governor is frugal and savings account is big so he is releasing funds for homeless services and mental health. We are currently reading details and working with statewide associations to figure out what it will look like. As more details become available, Stakeholders will get an update. We know some of funds will be used for DHCS to add additional positions
- **Ian**-Progress House will continue to be a contractor for Perinatal but will no longer provide services in woodland. Cache Creek Lodge will no longer be contracting on SUD side. They will be working with Probation side instead.

- Tracey is now overseeing Contracts Unit. She is working on RFP's for upcoming fiscal year. RFP's are notably smaller than this year. She hopes to have out in next month or so
