Delta Conservation Framework (California Department of Fish and Wildlife) – We are in the comment period – Oct 19 evening and Oct 30 midday public meetings. Conservation piece of the legislature.

5. INFORMATIONAL ITEM

a) Results for Clarksburg Organics Program and next steps (Marissa Juhler)

- Results of survey – Community supported the program, wanted price reduction, possibility for reduction by \$5 in 2019. County can provide biodegradable bags. There is potential for exemption if you document backyard composting. Possibility for spring and fall collection once a week at no additional cost.
- Should we resurvey? 43% response
- Waste management will continue to honor the \$10 rate per pickup

County would like to provide low income and/or senior program. We can actually have two bins, but we may need to call Marissa.

Unanimously agreement from the community advisory community to continue the pilot to 12/31/2018. June of 2018 resurvey. Marissa to return in Summer 2018.

6. DISCUSSION ITEM

a) Transportation Management in the area

Three way stop approved by the Board of Supervisors on Tuesday October 12, 2017 at Freeport Bridge and South River Rd.

Projects that could cause impacts

- 1) Housing units at Delta Shores and in West Sacramento are planned. This will increase the traffic concerns/issues. Want to determine how many housing units are being proposed?
- 2) North Bay Alternative Aqueduct Project (Fairfield, Napa, Vacaville etc...) Water quality issues causing need to pull more surface water. Proposing to place an out take in the Glide District. Project may be in hold pattern <http://www.water.ca.gov/engineering/Projects/Current/NBA/>
- 3) West Sacramento/Clarksburg Right of Way – West Sacramento wants to activate their ownership of the railroad right of way. Interest raised in use the railroad right of way south and west of Clarksburg.

General Issues

- 1) Turn on to the bridge for trucks – Agricultural community
- 2) Issues with biking
- 3) Concerns with Sacramento County side of the Freeport Bridge
- 4) West Sacramento issues with egress from Southport area
- 5) Access from I-80 to I-5
- 6) Transportation related flood management and emergency services support

Possible projects to help

- 1) Create a northwest interceptor pipeline road with an additional bridge north of Freeport that connected to the Ag industrial area on the west side of west sac south of Southport.
- 2) Bike Trail connection
