The Conclusion of the 2018 Primary Election Canvass Period in Yolo County

Woodland, CA – The Yolo County Elections Office will be scanning the remaining unprocessed ballots on Tuesday June 19, 2018 for the 2018 Primary Election. “As part of our ongoing commitment to transparency, the public is invited to come to our office tomorrow to view this process firsthand,” says Jesse Salinas, Yolo County Clerk /Recorder/Assessor and Registrar of Voters. As of June 15, 2018, there are an estimated 8,262 ballots remaining including 6,300 vote-by-mail ballots, 1,296 provisional ballots, 553 duplicated damaged ballots and 113 conditional ballots. Once these ballots have been processed, this will conclude the canvassing period for the Yolo County Elections Office and certified election results will be reported to the Secretary of State. Official 2018 Primary Election results will be reported and posted on our website on Wednesday June 20, 2018.
