 - MHSA Regulatory Amendments Adopted by Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC), effective July 1, 2018.

- **MHSA Regulatory Change Overview**
 - **Demographic Collection for minors:**
 - 12 and Under not required to report: veteran's status, sexual orientation, and current gender identity.
 - 18 and Under only responsible for reporting data should report only to the extent permissible by California education code, Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), Health Insurance Portability and Accountability of 1996 (HIPAA), and other state and privacy laws.
 - **Screening and referral requirement clarifications:**
 - Average duration of mental illness and treatment received data: only required for those referred to programs that are provided, funded, administered, or overseen by the county.
