RESOLUTION NO. 85-152

(Resolution Making Determinations Ordering the
East Yolo Reorganization, Subject to
Conditions and Confirmation of the Voters)

WHEREAS, a petition of application was submitted under the District Reorganization Act of 1965 to incorporate the subject territory and dissolve the East Yolo Community Services District, East Yolo Fire Protection District, County Service Area No. 4, Elkhorn Village Lighting District, Arlington Oaks Lighting Maintenance District, Oaks Lighting District, and Westfield Village Lighting Maintenance District, and transfer of the West Capitol Avenue Landscaping Assessment District to the proposed new city; and

WHEREAS, after conducting appropriate proceedings thereon, on October 14, 1985, the Yolo County Local Agency Formation Commission adopted Resolution No. 85-13, Resolution of the Local Agency Formation Commission Approving the East Yolo Reorganization (LAFCO Proceeding No. 794), a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference, which includes incorporation of the subject territory described in Exhibit A attached to that Resolution, dissolution of the East Yolo Community Services District, East Yolo Fire Protection District, County Service Area No. 4, Elkhorn Village Lighting District, Arlington Oaks Lighting Maintenance District, Oaks Lighting District, and Westfield Village Lighting Maintenance District, and transfer of the West Capitol Avenue Landscaping Assessment District to the new city and the formation of County Service Area No. 9 to

1 consist of the territory described in Exhibit B attached to that
2 Resolution; and

3 WHEREAS, by said resolution, the Board of Supervisors of the
4 County of Yolo was designated as the conducting authority respon-
5 sible for conducting proceedings for said proposal in accordance
6 with Government Code §§56430, et seq.; and

7 WHEREAS, on October 15, 1985, this Board adopted its resolu-
8 tion initiating proceedings for reorganization and setting a
9 hearing on the matter for November 5, 1985; and

10 WHEREAS, said public hearing was advertised and noticed in
11 the form and manner provided by law; and

12 WHEREAS, at said public hearing on November 5, 1985, the
13 Board heard and considered the value of all oral and written
14 protests, objections, and evidence presented or filed, and all
15 persons present were given an opportunity to be heard in respect
16 to said reorganization proceedings;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors
18 of the County of Yolo that it finds, determines and orders as
19 follows:

- 20 1. Each of the foregoing recitals is true and correct.
- 21 2. No request has been made for the exclusion of land from
22 proposed formation pursuant to Government Code §56436 and
23 this Board finds that all lands included within the proposed
24 formations will be benefitted thereby and no exclusions are
25 ordered.
- 26 3. This Board finds that the number of valid written protests

1 filed and not withdrawn is 2 and constitutes less
2 than 50% of the registered voters residing within the
3 affected territory and that no majority protest has been
4 made pursuant to Government Code §§35257 and 56438.1. In
5 accordance with those sections, this Board is required to
6 order the reorganization approved subject to confirmation of
7 the voters.

8 4. The Board of Supervisors certifies that it has reviewed and
9 considered the mitigated negative declaration adopted by
10 Local Agency Formation Commission and that it concurs
11 therein and the Clerk is directed to file a Notice of
12 Determination.

13 5. The East Yolo Reorganization consisting of the changes in
14 organization set forth in LAFCO Resolution No. 85-13 and
15 subject to the terms and conditions set forth in that
16 resolution is hereby ordered subject to confirmation of the
17 voters on the question thereof.

18 6. An election is hereby called to be held on June 3, 1986 in
19 the territory of the reorganization including the entire
20 territory of each proposed formation.

21 7. The proposition to be submitted to the voters to confirm the
22 order of organization shall appear on the ballot substan-
23 tially as follows:

24 Shall the order adopted on November 5, 1985
25 by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
26 Yolo ordering a reorganization affecting the
East Yolo Community Services District, East
Yolo Fire Protection District, County Service

1 Area No. 4, Elkhorn Village Lighting Dis-
2 trict, Arlington Oaks Lighting Maintenance
3 District, Oaks Lighting District, Westfield
4 Village Lighting Maintenance District and
5 West Capitol Avenue Landscaping Assessment
6 District and ordering the formation of a new
7 city under the general law (with an appro-
8 priation limit of \$12,942,877 with the
9 1986-87 fiscal year as the base year for
10 increases as provided by law) and the forma-
11 tion of County Service Area No. 9 under the
12 County Service Area law, be confirmed,
13 subject to the terms and conditions specified
14 in said order?

- 8 8. An election shall also be conducted to select the name of
9 the new city from the following proposed alternatives:
10
11 A. West Sacramento.
12 B. River City.
13 C. Marina Del Rio.
14 D. Riverport.
15 E. Riverbend.
16 F. Write in choice: _____.
- 17 9. An election shall also be conducted for members of the city
18 council, the officers of the proposed city required to be
19 elected.
- 20 10. The terms and conditions of said reorganization shall be as
21 set forth in said Resolution No. 85-13 of LAFCO.
- 22 11. The election shall be held in the manner set forth in
23 Government Code §56100 giving precedence as provided therein
24 to the District Reorganization Act of 1965 and the local and
25 general election provisions of the Elections Code.
- 26 12. Pursuant to Government Code §56443 and Article XIII.B of the

1 State Constitution, the vote required to confirm the order
2 of reorganization is a majority favorable vote within the
3 entire area in which the election is ordered held.

4 13. The County Clerk is directed to give notice of the special
5 election as required by law.


6 14. This Board of Supervisors ordered that the election called
7 by this order be consolidated with the primary election to
8 be held throughout the County on June 3, 1986, and that
9 these elections called herein and the primary election be
10 held in all respects as if there were only one election.

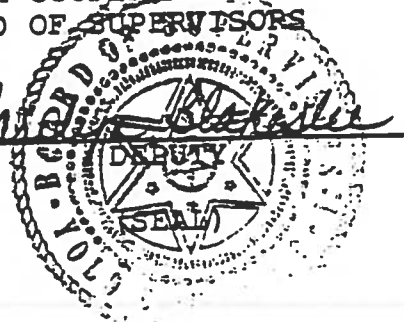

4. The project ~~will~~/will not have a significant effect on the environment.

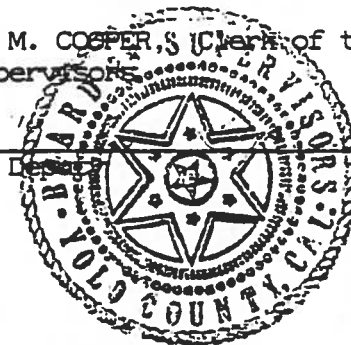
