SUBJECT: Correction to the FY2008 Capital Fund Program Annual

Statement and Five-Year Action Plan within the FY2008-2009

Annual Plan Update.

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS:

That the Board of Commissioners adopt the Annual Plan with the following revision of the FY 2008 Capital Fund Program Annual Statement and 5-Year Action Plan as part of the FY 2008 Annual Plan.

BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION

A mathematical error has been discovered within the FY 2008 Capital Fund Program Annual Statement. This error carries across into the 5-Year Action Plan as well. The FY 2008 Capital Fund Program Annual Statement as submitted to the Board is \$868.00 short of actual anticipated grant. This has resulted in a net increase of \$868 to the Annual Grant Amount for FY 2008 and in planning for years 2009 thru 2012. The corrected Annual Grant Amount is \$1,000,964 per year.

Because of the error, the FY2008 Capital Fund Program Annual Statement and 5-Year Action Plan must be amended to reflect the corrected final grant amounts; to do this, Budget Line Item (BLI) amounts within the Annual Statement and 5-Year Action Plan have been adjusted. A summary of these proposed adjustments is as follows;

The actual Capital Fund grant amount of \$1,000,964 for the FY 2008 Capital Fund Plan has been approved by congress but FY 2009 thru FY 2012 has not. Each year, YCH must update and submit its 5-Year Action Plan using the current approved grant amount. This allows YCH flexibility to move work items around within a 5-year period to best fit the need of the agency without further HUD approval.
