## Recycling: Back to the Basics

Recycling is at a crossroads in California and across the globe. A crackdown from China on what materials it will accept and how “clean” those materials must be, is causing a ripple effect throughout the industry that ends in how you sort materials in your kitchen.



What you think is recyclable might not be and how you handle the materials you recycle might need to change.

Our primary and immediate task is to clean up the recycling stream.



Contamination impacts the quality of recyclable materials. For example, food and liquid in a recycling container can mix with otherwise good paper and cardboard turning those recyclable materials into trash.

Here’s how you can help:



- Please make sure you’re not placing trash in your recycling.
- Stick to general rules above to help the environment and keep recycling sustainable.
- When in doubt, place a material in the trash.

### Recycling Service Available In Your Area!

Did you know that ALL Waste Management customers have access to recycling service at their property?



No matter where you live in Yolo County, if you have trash service with Waste Management, you are eligible for recycling service too!

A 96 gallon recycling cart will cost \$34.52 a month and will be serviced every other week. If you need more space, a 4-yard dumpster costs \$292.23 a month.
