Davis Community Meals and Housing is a non-profit, non-denominational organization whose mission is to provide low-income and homeless individuals and families with housing, food, and human services to help them rebuild their lives.

DCMH was created in 1990 by the initiative of members of the Episcopal Church of St. Martin in Davis and other religious and civic organizations as well as independent supporters. DCMH began operations in February 1991 when our first Tuesday evening meal was served.

Currently, we are serving three meals per week, operating a resource center, a street outreach program, providing emergency shelter to individuals, transitional housing programs for individuals and families, temporary supported housing for chronically homeless individuals and permanent supportive housing at Cesar Chavez Plaza. Our membership exceeds 2,200 individuals and over 100 organizations who lend their support through volunteer service, financial and in-kind contributions.

What does DCMH do?

- Provides a free meal on Tuesday and Thursday evenings and a Saturday lunch, 52 weeks a year, open to all in our community at St. Martin's Church, 640 Hawthorn Lane, Davis, CA
- Offers Emergency Shelter and Transitional Housing for adult individuals. The facility serves 16 men and women in a dormitory setting. It is located at 1111 H Street, Davis
- Family Transitional Housing for 5 families at scattered sites in Davis.
- New Pathways-temporary supported housing for chronically homeless individuals
- Permanent Supportive Housing at Cesar Chavez Plaza
- Resource Center services such as showers, emergency food and clothing, mail services, telephone use and necessities. The Resource Center is open to the general public
