West Coast Arborists, Inc. Yolo County Service Area 6 – Vegetation Management 2018 Scope of Work

West Coast Arborists, Inc. will be performing levee vegetation management services for the Yolo County Service Area 6 ("CSA 6") levee system.

Trees located along the CSA 6 levee, on both the landside and waterside slopes, will be trimmed up to approximately 8 feet. This trimming is an important vegetation management service as it will increase levee visibility during inspections and overall accessibility to the levee.

In addition to the trimming, all dead and fallen material that currently exists on levee slopes will be removed.

Services shall be provided from March 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018, however the total contract amount for these services is not to exceed \$45,000.
