YOLO COUNTY MHP DEFINITION OF LONG-TERM CARE BENEFICIARY

A. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish and inform Yolo County's Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) staff of the definition of "long-term care beneficiary" as required under Title 9 C.C.R. Chapter 11 §1810.400(c)(2)(A)(1).

B. FORMS REQUIRED/ATTACHMENTS: N/A

C. DEFINITIONS:

1. Specialty Mental Health Services (SMHS) shall include services as defined by Title 9 C.C.R. §1810.247.

D. POLICY

Yolo County Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) acting through its' Mental Health Plan (MHP) defines a "Long-term care beneficiary" as a client:

- 1. Who, after face-to-face assessment, is expected to require treatment for more than one (1) year and/or;
- 2. Is likely to require more than one (1) type of Specialty Mental Health Service.
