CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY WEEK IS SEPTEMBER 23-29, 2018

Car crashes are a leading cause of death for children ages 1-13. Many times, deaths and injuries can be prevented by proper use of car seats, boosters and seat belts. The Yolo County Car Seat Safety Program has partnered with Sutter Davis Hospital, CommuniCare Health Centers and AAA Insurance to provide car seat inspections on Friday, Sept. 28th from 4pm-6pm in the Sutter Health parking lot located at 2000 Sutter Place, Davis, CA.

Parents and caregivers in Yolo County can ask questions and receive hands-on instruction from Certified Child Passenger Safety Technicians on how to choose the right car seat for a child's age and size, how to correctly install the seat in their vehicle, and how to use that seat correctly every time. They will also discuss the importance of registering car seats in case of a recall.

CAR SEAT RECYCLING



Did you know that Yolo County Car Seat program recycles car seats? This program takes car seats that are used, outgrown, unwanted, expired and/or in a car crash and recycles them. They cut straps and remove the padding. There are drop-off locations in Davis, Winters, Woodland, and West Sacramento.
