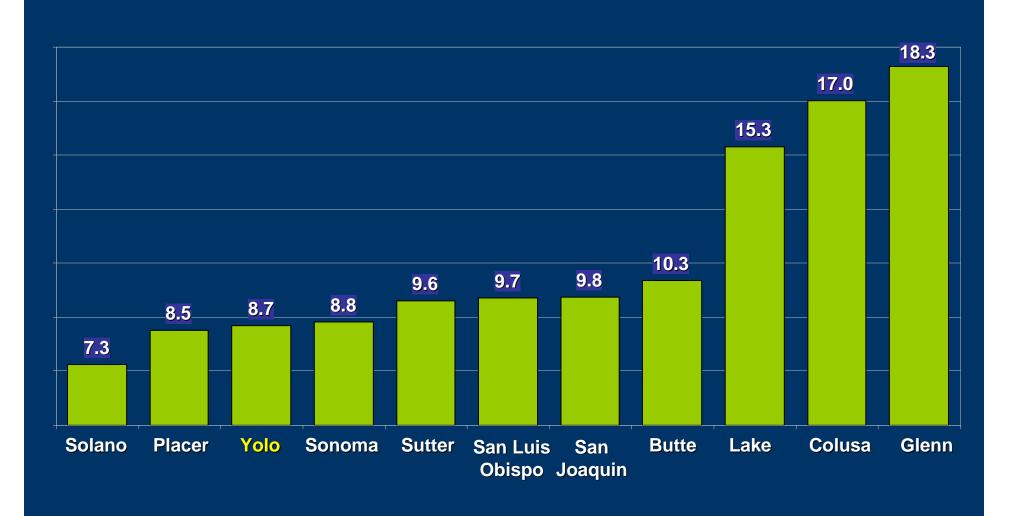

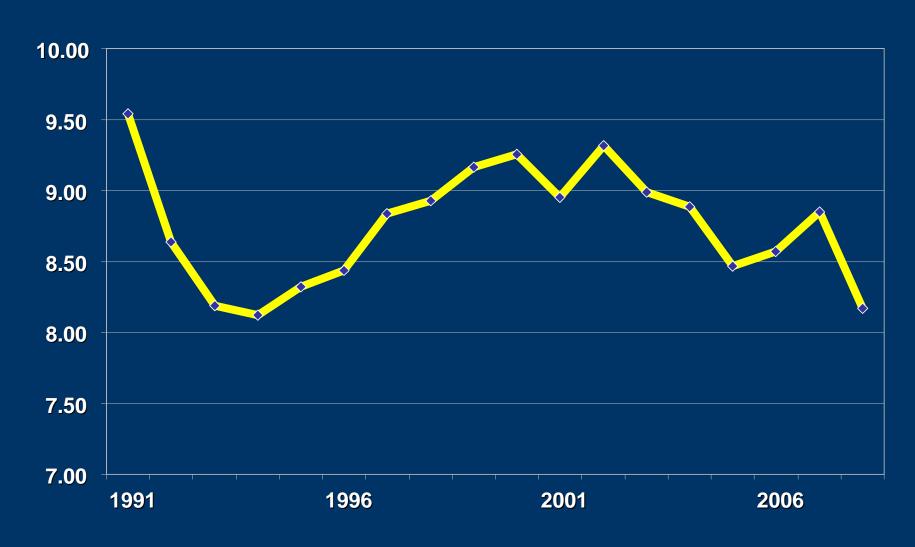
Yolo County Population Growth



County Employees per 1,000 Residents



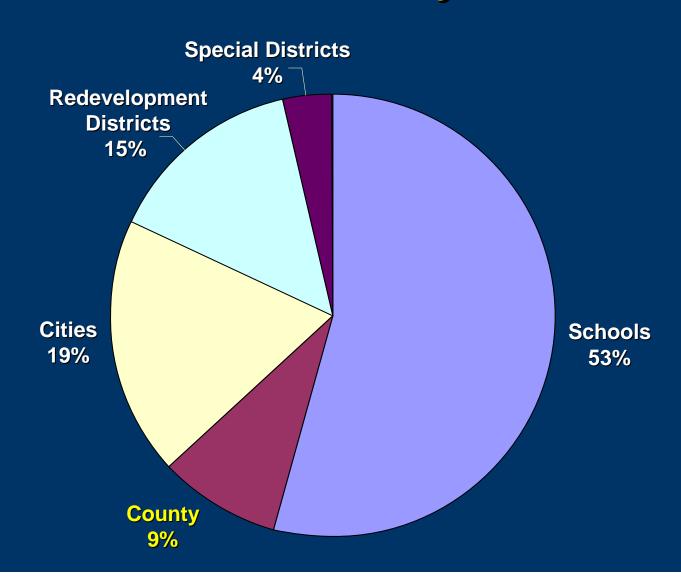

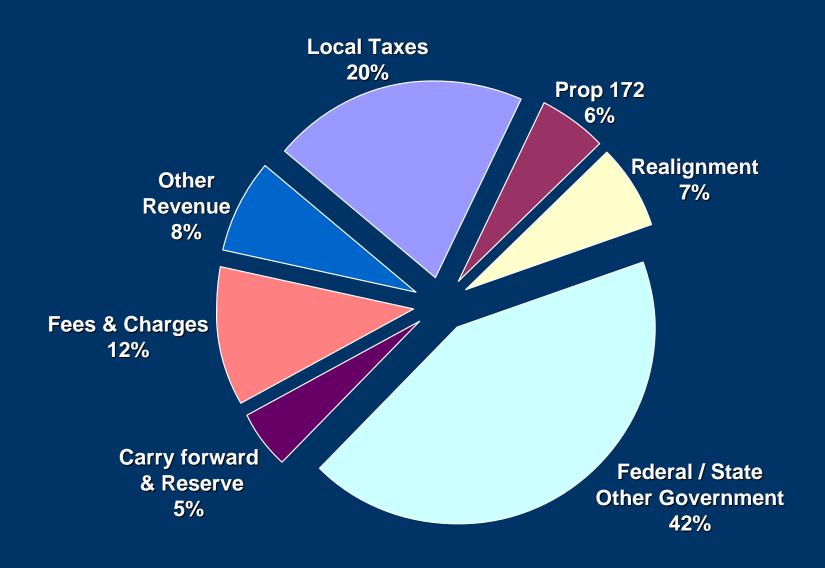
Total Expenditures per Capita



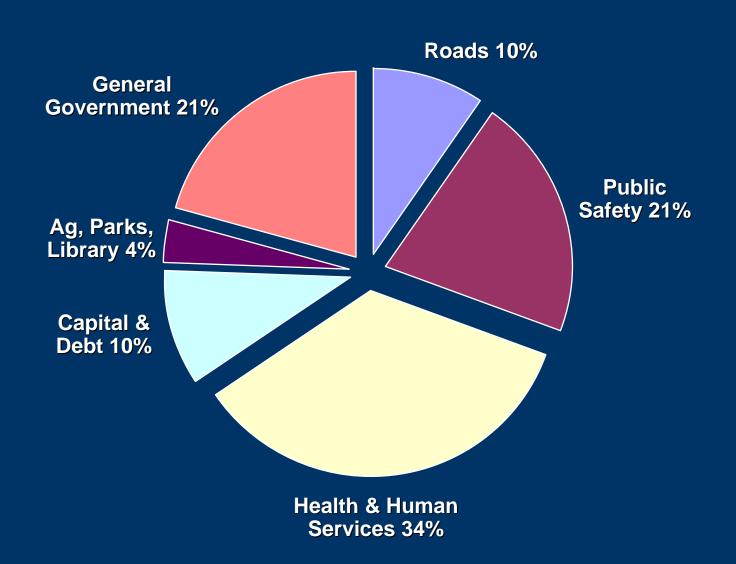
Property Tax Shares in Yolo County



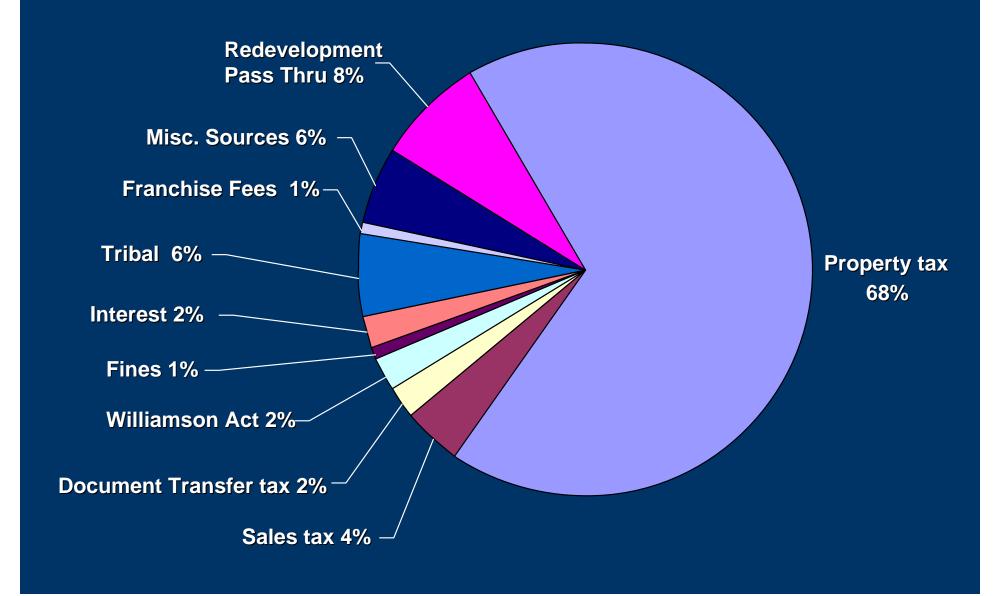
Total Funds Sources



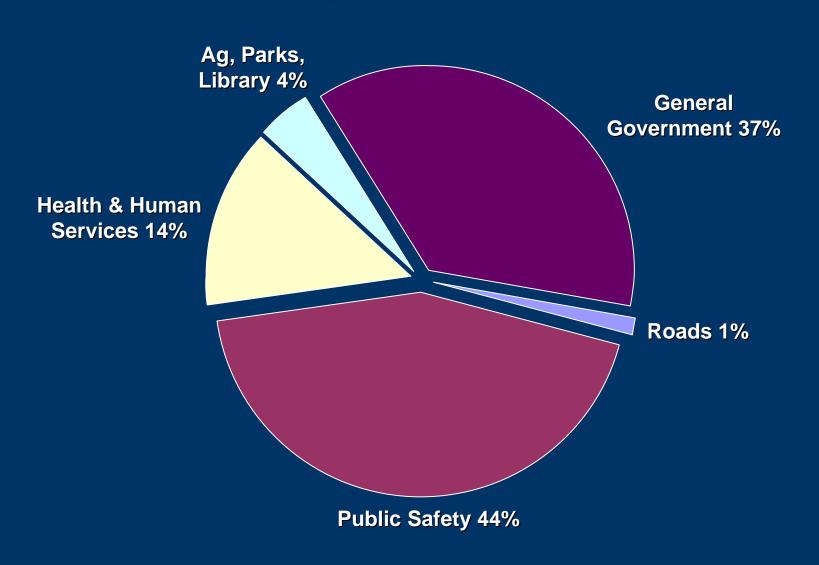
Total Spending by Program Area



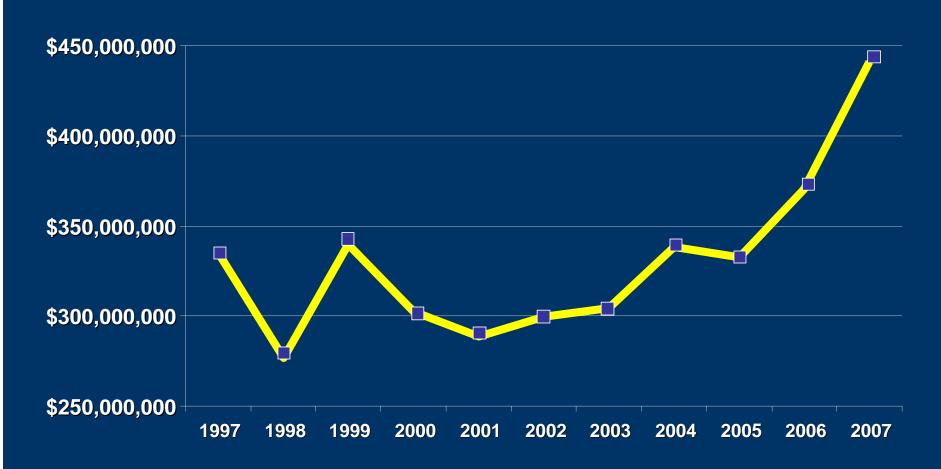
General Purpose Revenues
