Voter Alert: Robocalls Making Misleading Statements

Woodland – The Yolo County Elections Office is alerting residents about a misleading robocall currently circulating that wrongly claims there is an error in one of the ballot titles for the November 6th General Election. The robocall, which is sponsored by a campaign, states there is an error printed on the title for one of the propositions in voting materials mailed to you by your local registrar. In actuality, ballot titles are prepared by the state Attorney General, with no alterations made by the Yolo County Registrar of Voters.

“Voters should be aware of misleading claims that can cause confusion, especially during election seasons.” said Yolo County Assessor/Clerk-Recorder/Registrar of Voters Jesse Salinas. “Our office is committed to maintaining the integrity of every election we oversee and will continue to monitor any issues or concerns brought to our attention.” The Yolo County Elections Office urges voters to be vigilant about election-related robocalls or materials.
