## November Programs at the Esparto Regional Library

(Woodland, CA) –Bring the family and friends to the following fall programs held during the month of November at Yolo County’s Esparto Regional Library, located at 17065 Yolo Avenue in Esparto:

- **November is Native American Heritage Month!** All Yolo County Library branches will celebrate with displays, highlighting the history and culture of the Yocha Dehe Wintun Nation, and recommended reading.
- **November 6: Get Out the Vote!** The Library is a polling location. Vote by Mail ballots may be dropped off in the ballot box during library business hours until Monday, November 5 at 2:00 p.m.

- **November 10: Garden Composting/Vermicomposting, 10:15 a.m.** This information program is presented by the University of California Cooperative Extension Master Gardeners of Yolo County.
- **November 13: Free Computer Class, 10:30 a.m.** Basic computer class covering simple tech support, beginner terminology, library computer resources and a Q & A session. Registration is required and will be limited to the first ten signups. To register, call (530) 787-3426 or sign up at the library service desk. This class will be offered on the second Tuesday of each month.
- **November 15: Northern California Bats: Bats Eat Bugs, 3:30 p.m.** Join Corky Quirk for a family experience to learn all about bats in your area. There will be live bats!
- **November 28: Senior Adult Art Class with Julie, 10:00 a.m.** Enjoy a hands-on class featuring acrylic paint with tape on canvas. This class will be held at the Senior Program at the Country Villa Mobile Estates at 26262 County Road 21A, Esparto, CA 95627.
- **November 29: Children’s Art Class with Julie, 3:30 p.m.** Enjoy a hands-on class featuring painting on ceramic tiles. All ages are welcome.

The following ongoing programs continue in November:

- **English Conversation Group, Tuesdays at 1:15 p.m.** Converse and improve your English in a fun and relaxed setting with the aid of a group facilitator. Drop-in visitors are always welcome.
- **Hora de Cuentos / Bilingual Spanish Story Time (Ages 0-5), Thursdays at 10:30 a.m.** Children (ages 0-5) and their parents or caregivers are invited to join us for stories, songs, movement, rhymes and finger-plays. All bilingual story times are provided through a grant from First 5 Yolo.

**Food for Fines & Pay It Forward:** The Yolo County Library is offering residents and library card holders two opportunities to feed and support their communities this holiday season with ‘Food for Fines’ and ‘Pay It Forward.’

The first opportunity is through the Library’s annual “Food for Fines” program that allows library card holders to clear \$1 from their Yolo County Library overdue fines for each nonperishable food item donated at the circulation desk of any Yolo County Library location. The program runs November 13 through December 31 and there is no limit to the number of donations or reduction in fines cardholders can receive. Library card holders are welcome to donate even if they do not have any overdue fines.

The second opportunity is through the Library’s ‘Pay It Forward’ program that allows customers to help library card holders pay off their overdue fines. Customers are welcome to donate money and write a message on a star-shaped note that will be posted on a board behind the circulation desk.

All programs are sponsored by the Friends of the Esparto Regional Library, are free to attend and, unless otherwise stated, no registration is required.
