Yolo County Hazard Mitigation Plan Survey & Public Meeting Nov 1

(Woodland, CA) – The Yolo County Office of Emergency Services is seeking the community’s input. As part of the process of updating the Yolo County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, residents are encouraged to provide their input by completing a survey and/or by attending an annual meeting where information about the plan, including the hazards identified, will be discussed.

Every five years, the Yolo County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan is updated and submitted to the Federal Emergency Management Agency. The plan addresses threats from potential hazards impacting Yolo County and identifies possible strategies to reduce those impacts. Yolo County, the cities of Davis, West Sacramento, Winters and Woodland, the Yocha Dehe Wintun Nation, Yolo County Housing and numerous special districts participate in developing this multi-jurisdictional plan.

The public is also encouraged to provide input by completing a survey to identify the community’s concerns about hazards. An online survey can be found at: www.yolocounty.org/OES and printed copies are available at all Yolo County Library branches. Surveys may be submitted at the November 1 public meeting.
