Daily Operations:

The day-to-day operations are going well some notable issues and tasked completed were

- Installed Micro Lift/IND probes at Site A & B (Lift Stations) for odor control and FOG control.
- Influent screen installed and operational.
- > Influent submersible pumps installed site A completed.
- Storm Pond completed.
- ➤ Wastewater Plant nearly completed (still removing old chemicals).
- ➢ New Chlorine Tank delivered.
- ➤ Irrigation Pump #1 replaced.
- Recycled Pond Ladder installed.
- ➤ Wastewater Backflow assembly installed.
- Groundwater monitoring sampling (completed tomorrow).
- Emergency Generators Serviced.

Upcoming Projects:

- Emergency overflow Pond clean up
- Recycle Pond clean up.
- Sludge Judge 2"to 8" from the inlet to east bank, sludge looks more like algae than solids
- Patriot environmental, Aqua Natural, and Blue frog will be putting in bid proposals for removal of irrigation pumps and filter rebuild.
