Non-Residential Energy Code Training

(Woodland, CA) – The Yolo County Planning and Public Works Department Building Inspection Division will present a training program on California Title 24 Non-Residential Energy Code Compliance on Tuesday, July 15, 8:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at 292 W. Beamer Street, in Woodland. The training is being sponsored by the California Energy Commission, PG&E, and EnergySoft. There is no fee for registration and seating is unlimited. Participants will receive a certificate of attendance, course hand-outs and refreshments.

The Title 24 Energy Code Compliance training is appropriate for contractors, business owners, inspectors, plans examiners, building officials and design professionals. Topics will include:

- Interior lighting
- Exterior lighting
- Mechanical (HVAC)
- Cool roofs

Martyn C. Dodd, principal of EnergySoft, will conduct the training. EnergySoft is a bay area company that specializes in performance based energy analysis. Mr. Dodd has written software used in the California Title 24 Energy Code Compliance for the past 25 years. He is one of the original authors of the 1992 Non-residential Alternative Calculation Method manual which defines the rules for code compliance software and has become the model for both national and international code compliance software procedures.
