 - Community Meeting convened on 2/12/19 with residents of South River Road. Several
 ideas to mitigate traffic were discussed. Concerns about the levee road from the Freeport
 bridge north to West Sacramento. SPEED LIMIT, ROAD SAFETY, COMMUTER TRAFFIC,
 NAVIGATION WEBSITES. Recommendations will be presented to the CGPCAC in the future
 for consideration.
 - California Highway Patrol Officer, Steve Hawkinson and Yolo County Resident Deputy Zavier Feldon, updated their efforts to increase their presence on the South River Road. The CHP reported a number of speeding tickets were issued as well as warnings. He noted that more that 50% of the cars stopped were local residents. They intend to maintain their presence in the coming weeks.
 - Meeting held on January 30, 2019 at Supervisor Villegas District Office. Representatives from the Yolo County Sheriff, California Highway Patrol, Yolo County Community Services, and Yolo County Public Works were present. Issues discussed were the License Plate Camera Readers, Excessive Rate of Speed on South River Road, Engineering Options, and Signage.
