Who should apply?

What will committee members do?

The seven committee members will, based on their experience and expertise, review and provide input and recommendations for retention or deaccession of collection items from the YCHC.

- Each committee member is expected to attend a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 12 meetings, held once a month starting June 2019. The first committee meeting is mandatory to learn about committee guidelines and criteria for deaccessioning will be discussed.
- Committee members will receive photographs and collections information about selected objects that the Museum Curator has determined to be candidates for deaccession. These materials should be reviewed prior to in-person meetings by committee members.
- Committee members discuss pre-selected objects and vote on the status of the objects from the collection at the in-person monthly meetings.



How do I apply?

You can nominate yourself, or be nominated by someone else or a local nonprofit or educational organization.
