Purpose

This memorandum has been prepared by Larsen Wurzel & Associates, Inc. (LWA) in support of the Town of Yolo Flood Risk Reduction Feasibility Study under the Department of Water Resources (DWR) Small Communities Flood Risk Reduction (SCFRR) Program. This memorandum identifies non-local matching funding sources that could be secured to implement the identified alternatives.

Approach

The conceptual finance plan applies information from the Funding Sources memos prepared by LWA with funding information provided by the local agencies to identify potential non-local matching funds to implement the preferred alternative. This memo does not address funding mechanisms for identified multi-benefit projects.

Selected Alternative

The preliminary alterative screening resulted in the following options being carried forward; 1) Restore/Repair Cache Creek Left Bank Levee to USACE 1957 Design Profile, 2) Fix-in-Place Cache Creek Left Bank Levee to Pass 100-year Flow, 3) FEMA Accreditation of Cache Creek Left Bank Levee per 44 CFR Section 65.10, and 4) FEMA Accreditation of highway and/or railway embankment(s). The State of California owns, operates, and maintains the Cache Creek levees.

Funding Sources

Table 1 provides a summary of potential State and federal structural funding sources that could be sought to complete proposed improvements.

Recommended Next Step

The County should work to determine if advancing a land-based assessment or other local funding mechanisms would be a viable approach to raise local funding to advance the preferred alternatives. Continued coordination with the State of California will be necessary given the State, operates and maintains the Cache Creek levee system.
