- **Project Suggestions**
 - SSI Recipient CalFresh expansion and enrollment drive. (Program Expansion starts June 1st.)
 - Food Access Resource List
- **Project Selected:** CalFresh SSI Recipient enrollment and Nutrition Resource sharing with those not eligible for CalFresh.
- **Why This Project:** Nutrition is cross cutting across all priority areas from the CHIP, is important in all of our current priority areas (Mental Health, Chronic Disease Prevention, and Healthy Aging)
- **How to move it forward:**
 - May presentations by CalFresh and the food bank regarding how we can help to promote the new CalFresh expansion to SSI Recipients and overview of current services available to all other populations. Specifically around increasing SSI recipient enrollment in CalFresh and connecting those not eligible for CalFresh with nutrition information resources.
- **Considerations for moving forward**
 - What does health improvement mean for our priority areas if we move forward with these efforts?
 - What does food mean in the lives of those we serve?
 - How do we build capacity to ensure those whom we are serving receive the specialized assistance they may need to understand the CalFresh program and enrollment process? (Motivational interviewing)
 - How do these activities impact the social determinants of health?
 - What drives – health in relation to this project? (Upstream and Downstream).
