## Prop 47: Cohort 2 – BSCC

- □ Funding Recommendations: June 13<sup>th</sup>
- □ Funding Period: 8/15/19 5/15/23
- □ Total Applied For: \$5,974,893
- Grant would support creation of a restorative justice diversion program with wrap-around case management services for chronically homeless with mental health and substance use disorders.
- □ Lead Agency: HHSA
- □ Collaboration with HHSA, DA, Probation.



## Youth Reinvestment Grant - BSCC

- □ Funding Recommendations: June 13<sup>th</sup>
- □ Funding Period: 7/1/19 2/28/23
- □ Total Applied For: \$630,000
- Grant would support the creation of a pre-filing diversion program for juveniles on a county-wide basis.
- Lead Agency: Probation Department
- Collaboration between DA, Public Defender, and Probation.

# Adult Reentry Grant - BSCC

- □ Funding Recommendations: July 11<sup>th</sup>
- □ Funding Period: 7/1/19 2/28/23
- □ Total Applied For: \$499,999
- Grant would support hiring of a Reentry Coordinator and a
   Case Manager to work with post-release population.
- Lead Agency: CommuniCare Health Centers
- Collaboration between CCHC, DA, YCSO, and Probation.



# Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) – BSCC

- □ Funding Recommendations: September 12<sup>th</sup>
- □ Funding Period: 10/1/19 9/30/22
- □ Total Applied For: \$2,114,475
- Grant will be used to sustain and expand the Neighborhood Court program to handle felonies. Partnership with DRC to provide case management services to address complex criminogenic needs.
- □ Lead Agency: District Attorney
- Collaboration between DA, Public Defender, HHSA, Probation, and DRC.



## Incompetent to Stand Trial Diversion – DSH

- Award Notification: By June 30<sup>th</sup> (tentatively)
- Funding Period: 3 years, with possible extension up to 2 years
- □ Total Applied For: \$1,100,000
- Grant will support diversion through Mental Health Court for individuals deemed incompetent to stand trial on felony charges.
- Lead Agency: District Attorney
- Collaboration between with DA, Public Defender, HHSA, and Probation.



# Community Services Infrastructure - DSH

- Award Notification: By June 25
- $\square$  Funding Period: Project must be operational by 6/30/22
- □ Total Applied For: \$1,000,000
- Grant will support diversion programs by providing additional offender housing options by purchasing two properties.
- Lead Agency: County Administrator
- Collaboration between CAO, HHSA, DA, and Probation.



## Second Chance Act - BJA

- Award Notification: No later than September 30<sup>th</sup>
- □ Funding Period: 4 Years
- □ Grant Total: Up to \$1,000,000
- Grant would support hiring personnel to work with the postrelease population.
- □ Lead Agency: CommuniCare Health Centers
- Collaboration between CCHC, DA, HHSA, Public Defender, YCSO, and Probation.

**DUE:** 6/11/19

# Reentry for Adults w/ Co-Occurring Disorders – BJA

- □ Tentatively planning to pursue this opportunity.
- Award Notification: No later than September 30<sup>th</sup>
- □ Funding Period: 4 Years
- □ Match Requirement: 25%
- Lead Agency: TBD
- Funds could be used to support post-release services for individuals with both mental health and substance use disorders to promote treatment engagement.

**DUE:** 6/25/19

#### Justice and Mental Health Collaboration – BJA

- Award Notification: No later than September 30<sup>th</sup>
- □ Funding Period: 3 Years
- □ Match Requirement: 20% in Year 1 & 2, 40% in Year 3
- □ Grant Total: Up to \$750,000
- Grant would support expanding capacity for the Yolo County Mental Health Court (MHC) program.
- □ Lead Agency: District Attorney
- Collaboration between DA, HHSA, Public Defender, and Probation.
