RESOLUTION NO. 82-108

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(Resolution Ordering the Improvements, and the Formation of the
Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District and
Confirming the Diagram and Assessment and Constituting
Levy of an Assessment)

WHEREAS, Part 2 of Division 15 commencing with Section 22500 of the
Streets and Highways Code authorizes the creation of a lighting assessment
district; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 1982, this Board adopted Resolution No. 82-74
initiating the proceeding for the formation of the Clarksburg Lighting
Assessment District; and

WHEREAS, on July 13, 1982, this Board approved the engineer's report
regarding the formation of the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District; and

WHEREAS, also on July 13, 1982, this Board adopted Resolution No. 82-94,
Resolution of Intention to Form the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District;
and

WHEREAS, that Resolution of Intention ordered a public hearing to be held
upon the question of the formation of the assessment district and the levy of
the proposed assessment to be held at the hour of 11:00 a.m. on August 10,
1982, at the Chambers of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yolo,
Room 207, 725 Court Street, Courthouse, Woodland, California and directed the
clerk of this Board to give notice of the hearing by causing the resolution to
be published, posted and mailed as provided by California Streets and Highways
Code Section 22556; and

WHEREAS, the clerk of this Board gave notice of that public hearing in
the matter prescribed by law; and

WHEREAS, at the time set for the public hearing and at the location set

1 the Board of Supervisors held a public hearing on the question of the
2 formation of the assessment district and the levy of the proposed assessment,
3 and in doing so provided opportunity for any interested persons to be file a
4 written protest with the clerk and afforded all interested persons the
5 opportunity to hear and be heard; and

6 WHEREAS, no written protests were placed on file; and

7 WHEREAS, this Board has considered all oral statements and communications
8 made or filed by any interested persons; and

9 WHEREAS, it is in the view of this Board in the interests of the County
10 so to do;

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the Board of
12 Supervisors of the County of Yolo as follows:

- 13 1. This Board of Supervisors finds that each of the foregoing recitals is
14 true and correct and that all proceedings taken for the Clarksburg
15 Lighting Assessment District have been undertaken in the manner
16 prescribed by law.
- 17 2. It is determined that no majority protest exists.
- 18 3. The improvements for which the District was proposed to be formed are
19 hereby ordered, said improvements consisting of the installation or
20 construction of public lighting facilities, the installation and
21 construction of any facilities which are pertinent to the foregoing or
22 which are necessary or convenient for the maintenance or serving thereof,
23 or both, of the foregoing.
- 24 4. This Board hereby orders the formation of the Clarksburg Lighting
25 Assessment District.
- 26 5. The report of the engineer as on file with the Clerk of this Board,

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including the diagram and assessment forming a part thereof, is hereby confirmed as filed.


6. The adoption of this resolution constitutes the levy of an assessment for the 1982-83 fiscal year in the manner set forth in the report of engineer.

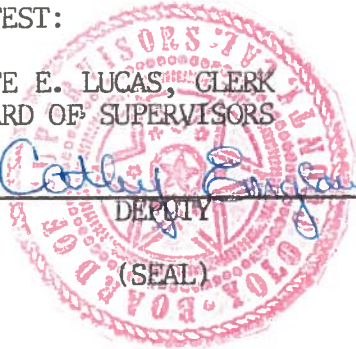
