RESOLUTION NO. 94-78
(Resolution of Intention to Levy and Collect Assessment)
(Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District)

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority conferred upon the County by Chapter 3 of part 2, Division 15, of the California Streets and Highways Code, commencing with § 22620, authorizing the levy of annual assessments after formation of an assessment district, the Board of Supervisors has caused to be prepared an Engineer's Report and Diagram which contains a full and detailed description of the improvements of the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District, the boundaries of said District and any zones therein, and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of lands within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Yolo County Department of Public Works and Transportation has filed a proposed report with the Clerk of this Board, in accordance with Article 4 (commencing with § 22565) of Chapter 1 of part 2, Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways code; and

WHEREAS, this Board proposes no new improvements nor any substantial changes in existing improvements of the Clarksburg Lighting District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. All the above recitals are true and correct;
- 2. The Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Engineer's Report as filed with the Clerk of the Board, with the following modifications:

- 3. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares its intention to levy and collect assessments within the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District for the Fiscal Year 1994-1995, excluding assessments upon Federal or State governmental agencies;
- 4. The existing improvements of the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District are as described in the formation documents thereof on file with the Clerk of this Board of Supervisors; there are no proposed improvements and/or substantial changes proposed

- 1 to be made in existing improvements of said District;
- 2 5. Said assessment district is known as the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District, and
3 is generally located in the Clarksburg Area of Yolo County, the precise location being
4 shown on the formation documents on file with the Clerk of this Board of Supervisors;
- 5 6. All interested persons hereby are directed to the Report of the Engineer, on file with the
6 Clerk of this Board of supervisors, for a full and detailed description of the improvements,
7 the boundaries of the assessment district and any zones therein, and the proposed
8 assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the district;
- 9 7. The Board of Supervisors hereby sets July 19, 1994, at the hour of 10:30 A.M., in its
10 chambers at Erwin W. Meier Administration Center, 625 Court Street, Room 204,
11 Woodland, California, as the place for hearing by the Board of Supervisors on the levy
12 of the proposed assessments;
- 13 8. All interested persons are hereby notified that they may, prior to the conclusion of said
14 hearing, file a written protest with the Clerk of this Board, or having previously filed a
15 protest, may file a written withdrawal of that protest. Such written protest shall state all
16 grounds of objection. Any protest by a property owner shall contain a description
17 sufficient to identify the property owned by him;
- 18 9. All interested persons hereby are notified that the Yolo County Board of Supervisors shall
19 hold a hearing at the time and place specified herein, or at any date to which hearing
20 may be continued, at which all interested persons shall be afforded the opportunity to
21 appear and be heard. The Board of Supervisors shall consider all oral statements and
22 all written protests made or filed by any interested person. At the conclusion of such
23 hearing, the Board of Supervisors may order changes in any of the matters provided in
24 the Engineer's Report, including changes in improvements, zones within the district, the
25 proposed diagram and/or the proposed assessment; and may adopt a resolution
26 confirming the diagram and assessment either as originally proposed or as changed.

Upon adoption, the resolution shall constitute the levy of assessments for the fiscal year 1994-1995, as stated in the Engineer's Report for the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District;

The Clerk of this Board hereby is directed to give notice of said hearing by causing a resolution of intention to be published one time in a newspaper of general circulation in the County of Yolo, such publication to be completed at least ten (10) days prior to the date set for the hearing specified herein, pursuant to Streets and Highways Code § 22553.

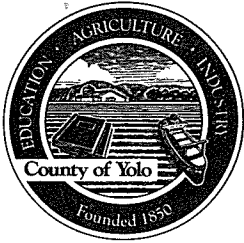

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

1. Approve the Engineer's Report of Estimated Assessments as filed with the Clerk of the Board.
2. Adopt the attached Resolution of Intention to Levy and Collect Assessments.
3. Fix July 19, 1994, at 10:30 AM in the Board Chambers as the date, time and place for hearing and filing objection or protests thereto.
4. Instruct the Clerk to publish notice of such hearing pursuant to Street and Highways Code Paragraph 22552.
5. At the conclusion of the Public Hearing, if there are no protests filed, or any objections are overridden, adopt the attached Resolution Confirming Assessments, and forward a certified copy of the Resolution to the Auditor-Controller and the Treasurer-Tax Collector of the County of Yolo.

REASON FOR RECOMMENDED ACTION:

The recommended action is being submitted in accordance with Chapter 3 of Part 2, Division 15 of the California Streets and Highways Code.

SUBJECT: Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District

BACKGROUND

An assessment of \$22.00 per parcel for each of the 148 parcels for the 1994-95 fiscal year has been established for the Clarksburg Lighting Assessment District. The assessment is the same as the assessment levied for the previous fiscal year.

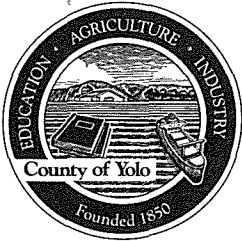
BUDGET IMPACTS:

There is no impact on any fund other than the special fund for this district. The amount of \$3,200 is budgeted for anticipated expenses. The \$22 parcel charge should produce revenue of \$3,256. There is sufficient reserve fund balance to cover unanticipated expenses.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENTS:

The street lights are totally operated, maintained, and replaced as needed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company. The County Auditor, Treasurer, and Public Works Department provide administrative services and receive reimbursement from this fund for their costs.
