DYSTONIC REACTION	
Adult	Pediatric
Signs & Symptoms	
<ul> <li>Facial grimaces</li> <li>Anxiety/restlessness</li> <li>Protruding tongue/jaw muscle spasm</li> <li>Torticollis (twisting of the neck)</li> <li>Oculogyric crisis (circular movement of the eyeballs)</li> <li>Spasms of the back muscles, causing the head and legs to bend backward and the trunk to arch up</li> </ul>	
BLS	
Assess vital signs O₂, titrate SpO₂ to ≥ 94%	
ALS	
Cardiac Monitor, Vascular Access	
Diphenhydramine 1 mg/kg IV/IM/PO  • Max 50 mg
