Medication Profile

Albuterol

(Ventolin, Proventil)

Class:

Bronchodilator/Beta₂ Agonist Sympathomimetic/Sympathetic Agonist

Action:

Albuterol works by causing relaxation of the bronchial smooth muscle in the bronchial tree and stimulates adrenergic receptors of the sympathetic nervous system. Beta₂ selective.

Onset: 5-15 minutes Peak: 1-1.5 hours Duration: 3-4 hours

<u>Indications</u>: <u>Contraindications</u>:

Bronchospasm associated with reactive airway disease or acute attacks of bronchospasm (i.e., COPD, asthma, and allergic reactions).

Hyperkalemia associated with crush injury

Hypersensitivity/allergy

Side Effects:

CV: Tachycardia, hypertension, palpitations

CNS: Tremulousness, anxiety, headache, restlessness

Notes:

• Supplemental continuous oxygen should be given in all patients receiving albuterol.
