Medication Profile

Fentanyl

(Sublimaze)

<u>Class</u>:

Opioid analgesic/synthetic opioid agonist

Action:

Analgesic with short duration of action.

Onset: IV/IN 1-2 minutes IM 7-8 minutes Peak: IV/IN 5 minutes IM 10-12 minutes Duration: 0.5-1 hour

Indications:

Severe pain Cardiac related pain

Contraindications:

GCS < 15 SBP < normal range for age Hypersensitivity/allergy

Side Effects:

CV: Bradycardia RESP: Respiratory depression

Notes:

- Monitor blood pressure, respirations, and mental status carefully.
- Use with caution with multi-system trauma and patients in whom respiratory depression should be avoided (SOB, COPD).
- May be administered in addition to Acetaminophen/Ketorolac for patients in severe pain.
