- You live in Yolo County
- You are pregnant
- You are parenting a child less than 2 1/2 years old
- You, or your infant, have a medical condition such as:
  - Gestational Diabetes
  - High Blood Pressure
  - Recently discharged from the NICU
- You are uninsured or eligible for Medi-Cal
