    - Received \$12 million \$9 million will be for a granting program
    - Non-Competitive Grant program Concept proposal on the website
    - Process Apply, meet with proponent, they want to work with project proponents to develop proposals that are the best for their communities,
    - Priorities
      - 1. Recreation and tourism
      - 2. Cultural
      - 3. Public Access
      - 4. Environmental Education
      - 5. Agricultural
    - Projects must involve funding of an asset
    - 20% of the funds must benefit severely disadvantaged communities
    - Draft guidelines to the Sept 4th Board meeting 30 day public comment
    - Finalize guidelines beginning of December for Final approval
    - January 2020 release must be used within a five year period no distinction between the Primary and Secondary zone of the Delta
    - Not funded on and all or nothing, they will consider projects that are leveraging funds from elsewhere
    - Interested in signage

- Under general obligation bond law Must contnue to bring benefit for 10 years at least must have 10 yearlong year management plan in grant planning
