Free Yolo County Flu Vaccination Clinics

(Woodland, CA) – The Yolo County Health and Human Services Agency will be holding the following free influenza vaccination clinics this fall:

- October 16, 9:00 a.m. 12:00 p.m. University Covenant Church 315 Mace Blvd. in Davis
- October 16, 4:30 7:30 p.m. West Sacramento Recreation Center, 2801 Jefferson Blvd. in West Sacramento
- November 6, 4:00 7:00 p.m. Winters Community Center 201 Railroad Ave. in Winters

In addition to getting a flu shot, follow these simple steps to avoid getting the flu:

- Wash hands often with soap and water.
- Regularly clean commonly-touched surfaces, like countertops, doorknobs, telephones.
- Don't share cups, straws or anything that goes in the mouth.
- Cover nose and mouth when coughing and sneezing, and promptly throw away used tissues.
- Stay home if sick.

Other important factors that help prevent sickness include:

- Eating more whole grains, vegetables and fruits.
- Getting enough rest and staying physically fit to help the body fight off disease.
- Not smoking and reducing exposure to secondhand smoke.
