#### GENERAL INFORMATION:

The purpose of the Vessel Owner's Report is to provide the Assessor with as much information as possible to aide in determining a fair market value.

- 1. Every person owning personal property shall upon the request of the Assessor file a signed property statement (Revenue and Taxation Code §441)
- 2. Vessels shall be assessed where habitually moored when not in service. (Revenue and Taxation Code §1139) Ownership on lien date (12:01 am January 1st) determines the obligation to pay taxes. (Revenue and Taxation Code §2192)
- 3. If, after written request from the Assessor, the property owner fails to furnish information, the Assessor, based upon information in his possession, shall estimate the value of the property. (Revenue and Taxation Code §501)

## WHAT TO DO IF or WHEN:

- 1. THE VESSEL IS ABANDONED OR DESTROYED: Notify the Department of Motor Vehicles within 15 days of the occurrence and surrender to the DMV the Certificate of Ownership and Certificate of Number. (California Vehicle Code, §9864) Notify the Yolo County Assessor's Office in writing at the address found on the reverse.
- 2. THE VESSEL IS INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT: Report any boating accident involving death, injury or disappearance, or property damage of \$500 or more to: California Division of Boating and Waterways Attn: Boating Accident Unit, One Capitol Mall Ste. 410, Sacramento, CA 95814 using form BAR-1 or online at boatingandwaterways.com
- 3. THE VESSEL OWNER'S ADDRESS CHANGES: Notify the DMV within 15 days if the address appearing on the Certificate of Number is no longer correct and furnish the DMV with the new address. (California Vehicle Code, §9865) Also notify the Yolo County Assessor's Office in writing at the address found on the reverse.
- 4. THE VESSEL OWNERSHIP IS TRANSFERRED: The <u>former owner</u> is required to provide the DMV a written notice of the transfer within 5 days. (California Vehicle Code, §9911) The <u>new owner</u> is required to apply for a transfer of ownership with the DMV within 10 days by presenting to the DMV the Certificate of Ownership and Certificate of Number. (California Vehicle Code, §9901) Also notify Yolo County Assessor's Office in writing at the address found on the reverse.
- 5. THE VESSEL IS MOVED: When the vessel is permanently moved notify the Assessor's Office in writing at the address found on the reverse.
- 6. THERE IS A VESSEL STATUS CHANGE: If on January 1 the vessel is in damaged condition or has been sold or permanently relocated, submit this information in writing to the Yolo County Assessor's Office at the address found on the reverse.

### CONDITION OF VESSEL:

Use the following descriptions to complete the condition portion (on reverse) AT PURCHASE and CURRENTLY, if "Fair" or "Poor" is marked, please explain below-

- (A) NEW/BRISTOL: A new vessel or maintained in a mint or fashion better that factory new. Turn key.
- (B) EXCELLENT: A vessel that has had above average care, equipped with extra electrical or electronic gear.
- (C) GOOD: Clean, attractive interior, normally equipped. Mechanically sound, mid-time on mechanicals and little to no extra work.
- (D) AVERAGE: Mechanically sound, requiring some interior and exterior work cosmetic work. Some mechanicals may be on the down side of their life-expectancy.
- (E) FAIR: Noticeable wear and tear, mechanics on the down side of life-expectancy, may require substantial yard work.
- (F) POOR: Vessel needs significant structural yard repair. Most mechanicals and electronics need repair or replacement, cosmetics may not be restorable. Cost of repairs and restoration may exceed market value of vessel.
