7. Report: YEMSA Update
- a. Kristin Weivoda, EMS Administrator reported:
 - i. We have started the RFP process for developing a new EOA Ambulance contract.
 - ii. We will be holding an iMCI Active Shooter exercise October 22, 23, 25, 2019 at the old Cinemark Movies 5 theatre in Woodland for Fire and Law Agencies.
 - iii. We have also held a Medical Point of Dispensing (MPOD) exercise at the Movies on Main Street event dispensing Flu Vaccines to the public in coordination with Woodland Fire Dept.
 - iv. We will also be hold Yolo County Employee Flu Clinics in October and November.
 - v. We will be holding a training for HHS Managers and Supervisors on Shelter Management in January 2020.
 - vi. We have a new employee starting October 28th, Douglas Brim. He will be an EMS Coordinator covering the RDMH Region IV position.
 - vii. We also just opened up a position for Emergency Planning and Training Specialist.
