5. COMMUNITY HEALTH BRANCH REPORT – Anna Sutton

- Medi-CAL/CMSP-Cindy Martin: Medical and CMSP enrollment continues to be the same. There has not been many changes to the CMSP enrollment. Continuing to ask the public to be patient when they are calling in. As mentioned before they have started a pilot program to triage incoming calls. The wait time for these calls is approximately 15 minutes and they are to handle 40 % of the calls that come in. 52% of the calls that come are having to be transferred to someone else to process. This has helped them to be able to help people quicker.
- CalFresh-Cindy Martin: The County saw half of what was expected for the population who receive SSI.
- Accreditation-Brian Vaughn: The annual report has been submitted.
- MCAH-Anna Sutton: MCAH will be hosting a webcast of the 2020Mom Forum, February 12 and 13 in the Clarksburg room. CEU's will be offered for Nurse's. A flyer is being finalized and will be sent out. You don't have to attend both days.
- Strategic Plan-Brian Vaughn: The board approved their strategic plan for 2020-2024. One of the items that they prioritized is to reduce economic and educational disparities for children and vulnerable families. Our department instruction will come from the county strategic plan.
- **Mobile Van-Brian Vaughn:** There will be a mobile van to reach out the homeless population in the county. It will have behavioral health, physical health, and dental health.
- **Health Alert-Anna Sutton:** There is a chicken pox outbreak in adults in residential care facilities. There were 2 alerts that went out one to the health care system and the other went out to facilities that serve those type of individuals.

- Breastfeeding Coalition-Lizeth Betancourt: The California Breast Feeding Coalition will be hosting the annual breastfeeding summit in Sacramento. They're going to be working on establishing a fourth trimester culture of supporting maternal mental health and how to support chest feeding for member of the LGBTQ community. Coalition members can get a discount.
- WIC-Lizeth Betancourt: Starting this week WIC will no longer be offering group appointments for prenatal education or other types of education. Clients prefer one on. starting this month, they will begin to offer one on one appointments. Online breastfeeding and baby behavior education can also be accessed online. If moms are working or unable to make their appointment they can take the class online and receive their contact credit and their benefits will be added to their E card.
- Partnership Health Plan- Dr. Chapman: Partnership Health Plan and Dignity Health are currently in some challenging negotiations. This is to renew the contracts between Partnership and Dignity Health for all their medical services. It has reached a deadline set by the state at the beginning of January. Because they have not reached an agreement, Partnership had to send a letter to all 18,000 Partnership members in Yolo County that the negotiations are ongoing and Partnership members could possibly lose their Dignity Health Provider. If an agreement between the two is not met, all 18,000 members will have to be reassigned to a new provider. At this time, it is unclear if Yolo County has the capacity to take offer care to all of the people that will be affected.
