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## 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Yolo County Health Advisory and Interim Guidance – UPDATED

Date: March 3, 2020

#### **Situation Update:**

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) announced that 16 laboratories, including California's Viral and Rickettsial Disease Laboratory in Richmond, California can perform testing for novel coronavirus. California has received additional testing kits. However, testing is still only available for those who meet clinical and/or epidemiologic risk criteria and is a person under investigation (PUI). There is NO widespread general testing of the public who do not meet criteria. Please continue to follow standard viral respiratory illness screening and practices, including respiratory viral panels and influenza testing.

Suspect COVID-19 patients are those with:

- fever or signs/symptoms of respiratory illness and a history in the prior 14 days of contact with a laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 case or travel to an affected country or area per the latest CDC recommendations, or
- fever or signs/symptoms of severe respiratory illness that requires hospitalization without alternative explanatory diagnosis (no source of exposure identified)
