March Programs at the Davis Branch Library

In recognition of the centennial of the 19th Amendment, the 2020 theme celebrates women who fought for women's right to vote in the United States; also honored are 20th and 21st century women who have continued the struggle (fighting against poll taxes, literacy tests, voter roll purges, and other forms of voter suppression) to ensure voting rights for all.
