

ROADMAP TO RECOVERY: Certain Outdoor Recreation Activities Resuming

As part of the "Roadmap to Recovery," Yolo County has amended the current shelter-in-place order to allow for certain outdoor recreational activities to resume that are deemed low risk for spreading COVID-19.

Important to Know



Yolo County residents are still under the shelter-in-place order and should only leave their home for essential purposes. An extension of the order will be announced in the near future.

Community indicators related to COVID-19 are being closely monitored. Indicators include: community-based cases, deaths, hospitalizations, and overall healthcare capacity. If indicators worsen, then restrictions will be put back in place.

Outdoor Recreational Activities That May Now Resume

- Golf Courses
- Fishing
- Boat Ramps
- Archery/Hunting Clubs



These activities still require social distancing, face covering guidance (if applicable), and good hygiene practices.
