# NEW RATES & CART SIZES (Effective June 1, 2020)

In response to new goals set by CalRecycle to achieve 75% diversion, Yolo County and Waste Management have developed enhanced services for your home. With these new goals comes the requirement for solid waste, recycling and organics (food and green waste) to be collected at each home and business or self-hauled on an every other week basis.

Waste Management, will be delivering three carts to each home between May 11-29. Upon receipt of these carts, please fill out the attached exemption applications if you wish to self-haul your waste on an every-otherweek basis to the landfill or if you would like to opt out of organics collection due to the fact that you already have an at-home compost bin or pile at your property.

With the introduction of cart waste services, your billing period will begin June 1st. Refer to chart at the right for a rate breakdown.

#### **ORGANICS SERVICE**

All customers have a 96 gallon cart

- Collects yard waste, food scraps and foodsoiled paper such as paper towels, napkins and greasy pizza boxes.
- Reduces the amount of trash generated at your home.
- Serviced every other week alternating with service for recycling carts.
- Exemptions allowed for qualified customers. Please see attached forms.



### **BULKY DROP OFF**

In an effort to reduce illegal dumping, the following is now available to all residents:

- A voucher will be mailed in April and September of each year allowing for free disposal of bulky items.
- Due to the current pandemic, the voucher will be mailed in May and will be good through June 30th.
- Each bulky voucher is good for free disposal of up to two bulky items OR up to one full size pickup load of trash.
- Qualifying senior citizens can receive curbside bulky service. Please call 530-662-8748 for more information.



# LOW INCOME SUBSIDY PROGRAM

 Qualifying customers can receive a 20 percent discount on their monthly service rate. Please contact Yolo County at 530-666-8856 to determine program eligibility.



# **EXEMPTION OPTIONS**

- Customers can apply to opt out of service.
- Please see attached Organics and/or Trash service exemption forms for details.
- Forms must be returned to County for review and approval. If approved, the cart/s will be removed and billing adjusted accordingly.
