WHAT IS IT?

On April 24, Governor Newsom announced the launch of "Great Plates Delivered" program, a meal delivery service for California's older adults.

Great Plates Delivered has two purposes:

- 1) Help seniors and other adults at high risk from COVID-19 to stay home and stay healthy by delivering three nutritious meals a day, and
- 2) Provide essential economic stimulus to local businesses struggling to stay afloat during the COVID-19 crisis.

Meals are delivered free of charge through this program. Individuals can receive up to three (3) nutritious meals a day.

The Great Plates Delivered program will run until June 10, 2020 but may extend to July if FEMA approves an extension to California.

WHO CAN APPLY?

- Individuals who are 65 or older or 60-64 and at high-risk as defined by the CDC:
 - Individuals who are COVID-19 positive (as documented by a state/local public health official or medical health professional),
 - Individuals who have been exposed to COVID-19 (as documented by a state/local public health official or medical health professional), or
 - Individuals with an underlying condition.
- Individuals must live alone or with one other program-eligible adult.
- Participants must not be currently receiving assistance from other state or federal nutrition assistance programs.
- Participants must not earn more than 600% of the federal poverty limit.
- Individuals must affirm an inability to prepare or obtain meals.
